The Connecticut Harm Reduction Alliance (CTHRA) is proud to announce its continued partnership with CT Addiction Medicine (CAM). Partnering with CAM has enabled CTHRA to further its service efforts all across Connecticut to vulnerable populations, including people who use drugs, people experiencing homelessness or unstable housing, and people engaged in sex work.

CAM has successfully supported CTHRA in various ways, such as allowing us to submit a funding request enabling CTHRA to purchase its first mobile RV for a Syringe Service Program (SSP) in Hartford and a space for our Registered Nurse to provide wound care, COVID-19 vaccinations, and housing and medical referrals to our participants. Additionally, CAM has been our primary referral source for immediate access to MAT services and has assisted with our opioid emergency response team.

CTHRA looks forward to a strong, continued partnership with CAM in the years ahead.
